

Adult Language & Culture Class Schedule

Learn to speak Swedish or Finnish in our adult language learning community at ASI! Our language classes start the week of March 27 and meet once per week for 90 minutes, over nine weeks. We offer small class sizes with a minimum of five participants, and a maximum of 15 students per class. Classes are designed for participants 18 years and older.

Tuition: \$99 ASI members, \$119 nonmembers. Please register by Monday, March 20 — after this date, registrants will be charged a \$10 late fee.

Materials: Purchase textbooks through the ASI Museum Store – pick up your book during museum hours or order by phone (612-870-3364). Class participants are responsible for having their materials on the first day of class. All classes requiring Rivstart A1+A2, ed. 2, need both the Textbok and Övningsbok.

Levels of Instruction

We offer language opportunities for beginners, as well as intermediate and advanced speakers. Students who have had little or no experience learning Swedish, should register for either:

Introductory Swedish A100 — a class specifically developed specifically to meet adult language students with basic or limited experience in second-language learning. This class is sure to lay a great foundation for continuation of Swedish language study. This class uses a text called, *Kort Kurs*, which can be purchased exclusively in the ASI Museum Store.

***Our classes marked Accelerated are classes that have been designated by our instructor team to move through materials at a fast pace.
